

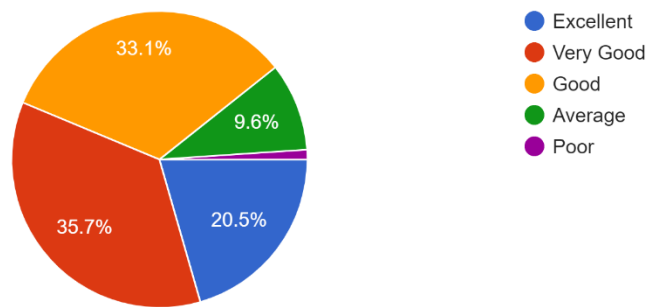

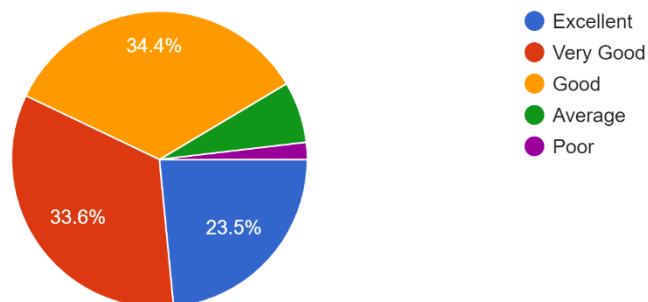
How do you rate the relevance of the units in Syllabus relevant to the course?

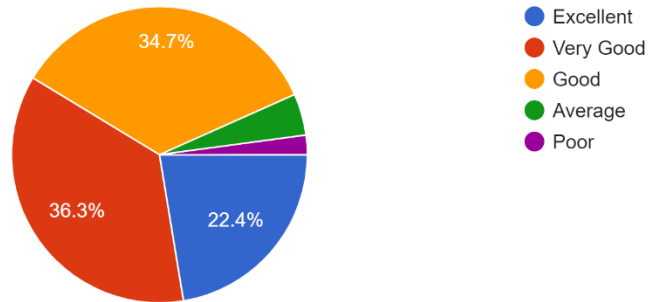
How do you rate the allocation of the credits to the courses?

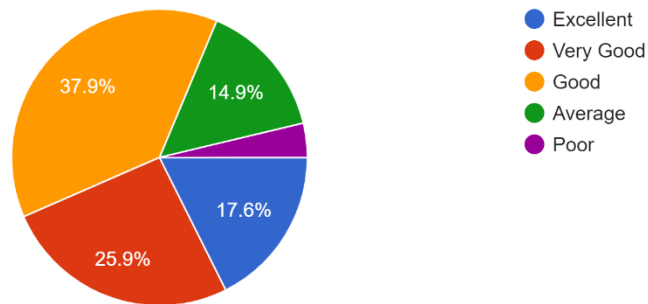
How do you rate the offering of the electives in terms of their relevance to the specialization streams?

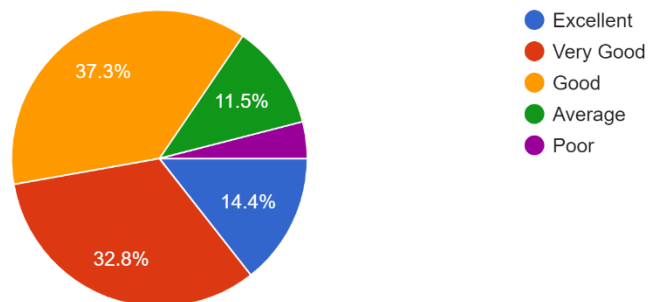
How do you rate the electives offered in relation to the Technological advancements?

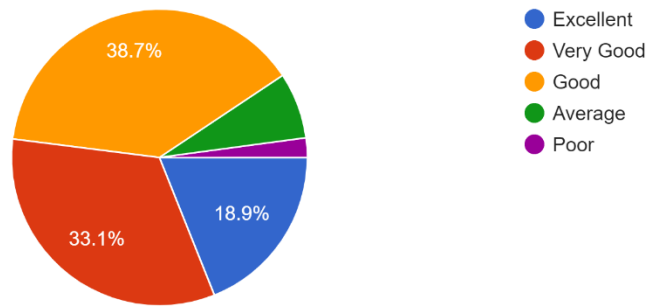
Rate the length of syllabus contents in terms of the load on the student

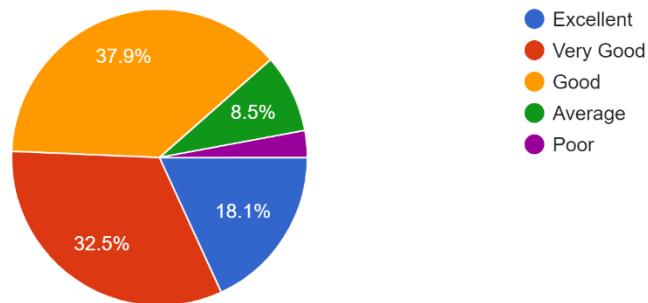
Rate the courses in terms of extra learning or self learning considering the design of the courses

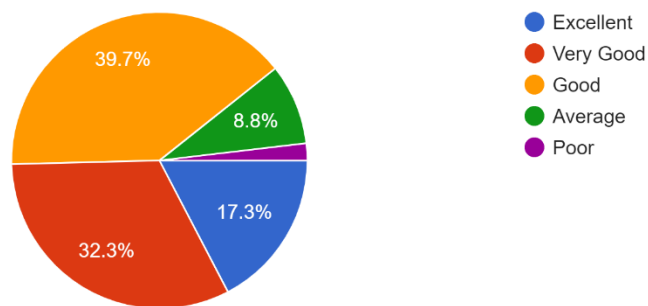
How do you rate the evaluation scheme designed for each of the course?

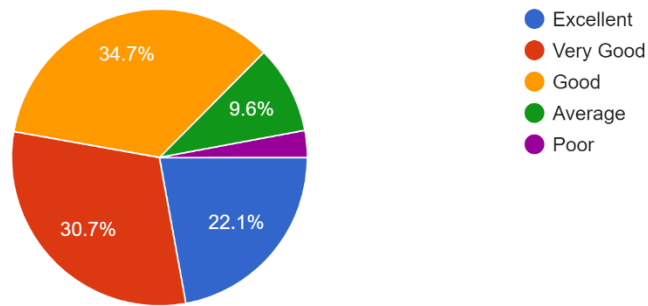
How do you rate the objectives stated for each of the course?

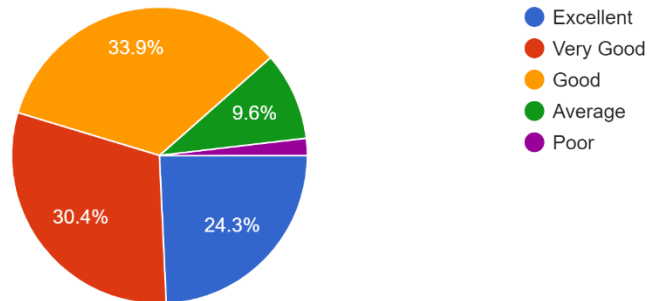

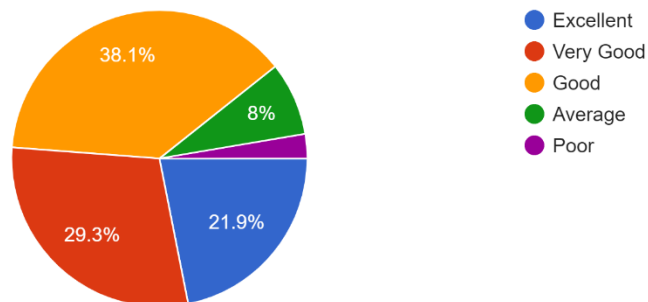

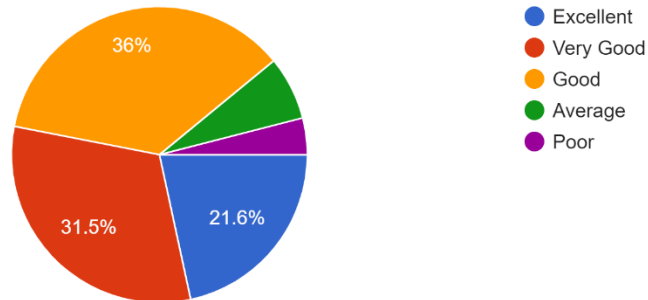

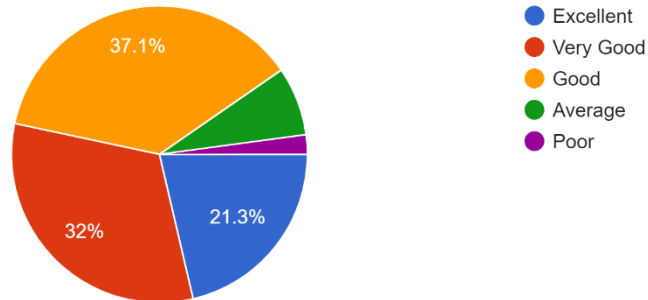

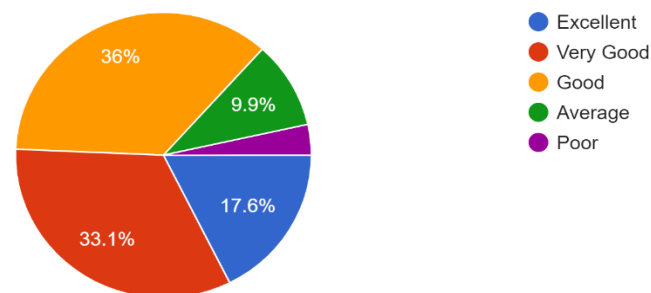
