

**NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME
REGULAR ACTIVITY REPORT 2016 – 17**

It is indeed a great privilege for me to give a concise annual report on the activities of NSS Unit, CMCS College during the academic session 2016-2017. National service scheme of College has experienced a dynamic change in the academic year 2015-16. Unit resumed its activity with its motto 'NOT ME BUT YOU' Our activities began with the following aims and vision. It seeks to raise awareness among the students on national integration, social harmony, general health awareness, personality development, personal hygiene, mental health and stress management. Almost all the volunteers are actively involved in creating assets for the community as well as in generating health and environment protection issues.

Some of the most important activities undertaken by this NSS unit may be summarized as follows:

Principal Dr. S.N. Shinde gave responsibility of NSS unit to Prof. Amit K. Mogal as NSS programme officer. College has sanctioned of 50 students (volunteers) for NSS unit by S.P.P.U. We had enrolled of 6 volunteers last year we had enrolled new 56 students in this year. So we had in total 62 NSS volunteers for current academic year.

With permission of principal N.S.S. advisory committee is framed and general meeting of advisory committee was organized on 17th June 2016. Discussion on activities and programmes will going to organized in this academic year is taken place, accordingly programme officer prepared the tentative Annual Plan for regular as well as special camping activities and other community development programmes.

Vanmahostav is celebrated from 1st July to 7th July week in college during which total 60 Nos trees were planted in college campus.

On 4th July a first general meeting of N.S.S. volunteers was organized in seminar hall. Prof. Amit Mogal explained the philosophy, aims and objectives of NSS to volunteers. Prof. D.W. Aher, HOD of computer science motivated students to actively involve in regular and special camping activities of NSS.

15th August, Independence Day is celebrated in college; N.S.S. Volunteers were participated in ground marking and other planning of flag hosting ceremony.

September blood donation camp was organized in college in which total 79 bags blood were collected. Total 43 NSS volunteers were worked as volunteer.

NSS Day (24th September) was celebrated before one day on 23rd September. On the occasion lecture of Prof. N.R. Kute was organized. He talks on personality development through NSS Voluntary Works.

On 24th September on the historical event was taken place in Nashik District. Lakhs of people were gathered in Nashik for a fight against the injustice, untruth. NSS volunteers were participated as volunteers for cleanliness drive and helping hands for police department to maintain discipline, law, and order.

On 26th November, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar's Birth Anniversary was celebrated as second constitution day. The preamble to the constitution was resided by Programme Officer, Head of departments, Teaching, Nonteaching staff and students of college. Volunteers of NSS were participated in managing the event very enthusiastically.

12th January National Youth Day, Birthday of Swami Vivekanda and Rajmata Jijabai Bhosale were celebrated. Prof. Amit Mogal gave talks about Swami Vivekananda life and Rajmata Jijabai.

On Cleanliness Day was observed on 14th January at College Premises. On this day, NSS volunteers cleaned the corridors of the college campus. A fact worthy of mention is that not just the NSS volunteers but all the teaching and non-teaching staff of this college also participated in this cleanliness drive actively.


26th January Republic Day was celebrated in college. NSS volunteers were actively involved in flag hosting ceremony.
