



## Annual Report of NSS Regular Activities 2017-18

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The National Service Scheme was started by Government of India, Ministry of Education and Culture, Govt. of India, in Collaboration with State Government in the year 1969 in 37 selected Universities. SPPU University has been participating in the scheme right from its inception. At present the scheme is run by the ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports in Central Government and Department of Higher & Technical Education in State Government.

National Service Scheme (NSS) has been introduced at Savitribai Phule Pune University since 1969 as a part of the academic programs and since then NSS has been functioning as a regular feature in the realm of our university education. The overall objective of the scheme is educational and service to the community is the activity through which the objective is sought to be achieved. It is a student-cantered program in which projects are implemented by the NSS volunteers in the community in close collaboration with the community and thereby it provides vast scope for the student's interaction with the people.

It is indeed a great privilege for me to give a concise Annual Report on the regular activities of NSS Unit, CMCS College during the academic year 2017-2018. National service scheme of College has experienced a dynamic change in the academic year 2016-17. Unit resumed its activity with its motto '**NOT ME BUT YOU**' Our activities began with the following aims.

### **AIMS AND OBJECTIVES**

- Understand the community in which they work.
- Understand themselves in relation to their community.
- Identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problem solving process.

- Develop among themselves a sense of social and civic responsibility.
- Utilize their knowledge in finding practical solutions to individual and community problems.

- Gain skills in mobilizing community participation.
- Acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitude.
- Develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters
- Practice national integration and social harmony.

**Some of the most important activities undertaken by this NSS unit may be summarized as follows:**

- ❖ Principal Dr. S.N. Shinde gave responsibility of NSS unit to Shri. Uday V. Chaudhari as NSS Programme Officer. College has previously sanctioned of 50 volunteers for NSS unit and in this current year College has sanctioned of more 50 volunteers for NSS unit by S.P.P.U. We had enrolled new 60 volunteers in this year so we had in all total 100 NSS volunteers for current academic year 2017-18.
- ❖ With permission of Principal Dr .S.N. Shinde Sir, N.S.S. Advisory Committee is framed and general meeting of Advisory Committee was organized on 24<sup>th</sup> June 2017. Discussion on activities and programmes will going to organize in this academic year is taken place accordingly programme officer prepared the tentative Annual Plan for regular as well as special camping activities and other community development programmes.
- ❖ On 20<sup>th</sup> July a **First General Meeting** of N.S.S. volunteers was organized in seminar hall. Shri. Uday Chaudhari explained the philosophy, aims and objectives of NSS to volunteers. Shri. D.W. Aher, HOD of computer science motivated students to actively involve in regular and special camping activities of NSS.

- ❖ On 20<sup>th</sup> September **Volunteers Meeting** was organised for new 50 volunteers sanctioned.
- ❖ 15<sup>th</sup> August, **Independence Day** is celebrated in college. N.S.S. Volunteers were participated in ground marking and other planning of flag hosting ceremony.
- ❖ On 15<sup>th</sup> August Grand mega social event “**10X breakthrough**” in collaboration with Nasik police was organised for helmet wearing and taking pledge to wear helmet while riding. 2 volunteers were participated in this programme.
- ❖ “**SWACCHATA PAKHWADA**” program is undertaken by The Ministry of Human Resource Development from 01-09-2017 to 15-09-2017, for spreading message of cleanliness not only the students but also in the surrounding areas. In this program 50 volunteers had participated and various programs are undertaken like Campus Cleaning, Street Cleaning, Hostel Cleaning and Market Cleaning.



- ❖ NSS Day (24<sup>th</sup> September) was celebrated one day after on 25<sup>th</sup> September. On this occasion lecture of Smt. B.R.Dhaneshwar, Women Police SubInspector, Gangapur police station was organised on the topic “**Safety for Girls**”.

- ❖ 7<sup>th</sup> October **Blood Donation**camp was organized in college in which total 16 bags blood were collected. Total 25 NSS volunteers were worked as volunteer.
- ❖ On 26<sup>th</sup> November, **Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar's Birth Anniversary** was celebrated as constitution day. The preamble to the constitution was resided by Programme Officer, Head of departments, Teaching, Nonteaching staff and students of college. Volunteers of NSS were participated in managing the event very enthusiastically.
- ❖ On 30<sup>th</sup> November, 10 volunteers were participated in “**AWAYAW DAN RALLY**” to create awareness about donation of human organs.



- ❖ On 4<sup>th</sup> December meeting about **Planning of Special Camp** was called by Shri. U.V. Chaudhari. All volunteers are present for this meeting.
- ❖ 12<sup>th</sup> January **National Youth Day**, Birthday of Swami Vivekanda and Rajmata Jijabai Bhosale were celebrated. Shri. BHANDARE B.J. delivered lecture on Swami Vivekananda's life and Rajmata Jijabai “An ideal mother”





❖ Celebrated Youth Week on 12<sup>th</sup> Jan to 18 Jan. Different Competitions like **Mehandi** , **Rangoli**, **Selfie**, **Elocution** were organised, 30 Volunteers actively participated in these Competitions.





- ❖ On **Cleanliness Day** was observed on 14<sup>th</sup> January at College Premises. On this day, NSS volunteers cleaned the corridors of the college campus



- ❖ 26<sup>th</sup> January Republic Day was celebrated in college. NSS volunteers were actively involved in flag hosting ceremony.
- ❖ List of senior volunteers who completed the required 120 service hours was prepared
- ❖ A **General Meeting** of NSS advisory committee was arranged on 15<sup>th</sup> Feb 2018. A general discussion was made on all the activities done in the current academic year, what was the problems and mistakes face during current year and how to overcome these mistakes in next year.
